



What To Do When Satan Attacks You

Sunday Evening Sermon by Ray Reynolds (6-17-18)

Introduction: How could Job emerge victorious after such a vicious attack by Satan (**Job 1-2**)? What can we learn from his story? Is it possible for us to resist him? It's my conviction that we do not spend enough time talking about spiritual warfare. We don't talk enough about the wicked acts of Satan. That needs to change. In our lesson tonight, I want us to see what we can do when Satan attacks. Let's study together...

Discussion:

1) What Does Satan Think About You?

- He considers you a foe (**Ephesians 6:11-17**).
- He sees you for your flaws (**I Peter 5:8-9**).
- He knows you will try to fight (**II Corinthians 10:3-5**).
- He marvels at your faith (**Romans 8:37**).
- He will exploit your friends and family (**Matthew 18:18-19**).
- He wants to steal your freedom (**John 10:10**).

2) What Do You Think About Satan?

- He is weakened when we take action (**I Timothy 6:12, James 4:7**).
- His adversary is our advocate (**Luke 10:19, I John 4:4**).
- His anger is misguided (**Deuteronomy 28:7, Psalm 91:1-4**).
- His attack will fail (**Isaiah 54:17, Romans 8:31**).
- His arrogance is his weakness (**Genesis 3:15, Isaiah 14:12, Ezekiel 28:17-18, Luke 10:18, Romans 16:20, I Corinthians 10:13, I John 3:8, Revelation 12-13**).
- His accusations will not stand (**II Thessalonians 3:3, Deuteronomy 3:22**).
- His appearance is deceptive (**II Corinthians 11:14, II Chronicles 20:15**).

Conclusion: The next time Satan mounts an attack against you, see it for what it is and refuse to be fooled by his trickery. Take your stand against him by putting on God's armor (**Ephesians 6:11**). Remember the truth about him. Remember the truth about what God can do through you. **Joshua 1:9** says, "Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous! Do not tremble or be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go." What do you do when Satan attacks? You say, "NOT TODAY SATAN!"
